Dolby E is a distribution bitstream capable of carrying up to eight channels of encoded audio and metadata. The number of programs ranges from one single program (Program Config: 5.1) to eight individual programs on a single Dolby E stream (Program Config: 8 × 1).

Since movie content is the largest class of programs to go on DVD, Dolby chose -31 dBFS as the reference level for audio on DVD, where 0 dB represents the maximum encodable digital sound level (full scale). The dialogue normalization parameter needs to be set to the LAeq level of your program material's dialogue.

Encoding and decoding. Dolby Digital operates in a world of ones and zeroes — digital information. Since the audio we hear consists of analog waveforms, not ones and zeroes, the first step in the process of creating a Dolby Digital audio track is to convert the original analog signal into digital information. Dolby Digital Live (DDL) is a real-time encoding technology for interactive media such as video games. It converts any audio signals on a PC or game console into a 5.1-channel 16-bit/48 kHz Dolby Digital format at 640 kbit/s and transports it via a single S/PDIF cable. A similar technology known as DTS Connect is available from competitor DTS.

The Dolby audio decoder is a Media Foundation transform (MFT) that encodes mono or stereo audio to Dolby Digital, also called Dolby AC-3. The encoder does not support multi-channel input, such as the 5.1 channel configuration.
