Due to better availability in the USA (albeit under various pseudonyms, for example 5881) many American amp builders used this tube for their amps. Most guitar amps use some variant of a 12AX7 in the preamp section. Though the preamp section of an amp is tremendously influential on the tone the amp produces, it's difficult to really draw many conclusions from the type of tubes being used. Of course as with anything there are exceptions to the rule.

12AX7: Since this is the most common tube in guitar amps, a wide variety of brands (including some resurrected old brands) are available to choose from. In Colby and Park amps, I use Tung Sol, Chinese, and JJ 12AX7 tubes, as well as the Sovtek 12AX7LPS. I typically use Tung Sols in the first preamp stage because they have a warm sound.

The Amp is Completely Dead If the amp is completely silent (no speaker hum or hiss at all) then the problem can be just about anywhere in the amp but you should suspect a bad tube, blown fuse or the power supply in that order.. Try a new rectifier tube. Try plugging in a guitar cable, turn up all the amp's volume, gain and master volume controls up a little and touch the tip of the guitar ...

KT66 tube amps were not as popular in the US, but we find KT66 amps to be a sleeper. We have yet to hear a KT66 amp that we didn't like. KT66 vs 6L6 . The KT66 tube is pin-compatible and electrically very similar to 6L6 tube. The KT66 can be used in place of 6L6, but with a caveat. The KT66 tube draws 1.27A filament current, where 6L6 tube ...
