Lab 4: Enumeration of Microorganisms - Biology LibreTexts

Using aseptic technique (i.e. flaming the neck of the tube or bottle after removal and before replacement of its lid), remove exactly 1 cm³ of the fluid and transfer to the dilution tube next in the series. Place syringe or pipette tip into discard jar. Mix the dilution well. Repeat steps 4 - 7 until the last dilution tube is reached.

together on the board and the students did the dilution using coloured water. Good practice for those who have never used a syringe too.

Serial dilution technique | Teaching Resources

Serial dilutions are often performed in steps of 10 or 100. They are described as ratios of the initial and final concentrations. For example, a 1:10 dilution is a mixture of one part of a solution and nine parts fresh solvent. For a 1:100 dilution, one part of the solution is mixed with 99 parts new solvent.
